The parade will begin at Alton Baker boat ramp, with registration check-in and line beginning at 8am at the Willamette River Festival mainstage area, near the DeFazio Bridge. Please check in first, and pick up your parade entry number bib before unloading your watercraft at the Alton Baker boat ramp, to line up for the parade. Line up will happen on first-come, first served during registration check-in. **ALL ENTRANTS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN A LIABILITY WAIVER ON SITE DURING CHECK-IN.**

Safety is paramount and rivers are unpredictable, and so are humans. Please be aware that **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY AND THAT OF ANY PASSENGERS ON YOUR WATERCRAFT, AND ANY DAMAGE TO YOUR WATERCRAFT AS A RESULT OF PARTICIPATING IN THE WILLAMETTE RIVER FESTIVAL PADDLE PARADE.**

Judges will be located on the DeFazio Bridge, watching as parade entries float downriver from Alton Baker boat ramp to the Valley River Center takeout. All participants are welcome to utilize our City of Eugene Recreation shuttle bus to help you get your car down to Valley River Center before the parade begins. There is no cost for this service, but we will only be providing this service prior to the parade. The last shuttle from Valley River Center back to Alton Baker will leave at 9:30am from behind Regal Cinemas. Please plan to self shuttle if you cannot make the trip with your vehicle to VRC before 9:30am. **All Paddle Parade participant vehicles must be parked in the Alton Baker main parking area if you are not utilizing the VRC shuttle service. NO PARKING AT THE BOAT RAMP!**

While the purpose of our parade really is to provide a safe, fun, and enjoyable group float experience, everyone who participates is eligible to receive a prize based on creativity and audience reaction.

Some ideas include:

Organizational/Business/Cause – who is supporting rivers in our community? Make it loud and clear – bring out your employees, wear your colors, create some fun signs and brag about who you are and what you do!

Love Your Willamette! – create your own theme to show us how much you LOVE YOUR WILLAMETTE! Dress up in costume, throw a dance party on your drift boat, create a 50-person rainbow unicorn floatilla... the only limitation is your imagination!

NO ONE IS REQUIRED TO DRESS UP OR DECORATE YOUR WATERCRAFT – but we will be giving out awards on stage at the Willamette River Festival at 3:45PM – and you could win one of many awesome prizes donated by area businesses and paddle industry partners!
